A+ Schools Participation Agreement

As an accredited A+ School, Festus R-6 students *may* qualify for **state-paid** tuition and fees to any Missouri public community college or approved post-secondary vocational/technical school. Eligibility for the A+ Program expires once one of the following factors has been met: 48 months after high school graduation, receipt of an associate’s degree, or the completion of 105% of the required hours for the student’s program of study. The financial incentives will come from the State of Missouri, not from the Festus R-6 School District.

To be eligible for these incentives, students and parents must be aware of and understand the criteria listed below which must be met by the student:

1. Must enter into a written *A+ Participation Agreement (this form)* and attend an A+ designated high school for at least three (3) years prior to graduation.
2. Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
3. Graduate from Festus High School with an unweighted grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
4. Have at least a 95% attendance record overall for grades 9-12.
5. Perform 50 hours of unpaid school sponsored and supervised tutoring/mentoring.
6. Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoidance of the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol. The signatures below give Festus High School A+ representatives permission to examine and evaluate the cumulative disciplinary record of the student.
7. Score Advanced or Proficient on the Algebra I End-of-Course Exam (or a higher level DESE approved end-of-course exam in the field of mathematics) or earn an eligible score on ACT Math.
8. Realize that tuition reimbursement will be made available only after the student has made a good faith effort to secure all available federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require payment (must complete a FAFSA form).
9. After graduation, maintain eligibility by enrolling and attending on a full time basis at a Missouri public community college or approved post-secondary vocational/technical school; and maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 point scale.
