Dear Parents and Guardians:

This summer, your child can experience the Festus R-VI School District summer school program called, Summer Academy. The Summer Academy program will be in session for only twenty-two days. The dates for the program will be Wednesday, May 30th through Thursday, June 28th. Although the district offers summer school for students entering kindergarten through high school in 2018-19, Summer Academy is specifically designed for those students entering 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades for the upcoming school year. (\*We DO NOT have late start Wednesdays. We begin each day at 8:10.)

Summer Academy has a new design with the interests of your child in mind. Students will be engaged in a variety of engineering design challenges and exploratory classes. Each day, students will be pushed to create, design, test, collect data, and redesign. Major design projects include water rockets, balloon race cars, and catapults! Students will learn to work together to problem solve and then compete against other teams.

In addition, students will be able to choose their preferred exploratory classes. Teachers have created a wide range of interesting classes from Escape the Room to Kitchen Science! You can find a full list of class descriptions in the application packet.

We have some field trips planned! We will be visiting Quonset Lanes, and the B&B Cinema in Festus. We also have a few surprises in store for the students!

We will also be working with the St. Louis Science Center. The Science Center staff will be coming to our school to conduct some scientific investigations. We started this partnership three years ago, and the students have loved it.

Summer Academy is open to regular district students and students who may reside outside of the district. I hope you will encourage your child to take advantage of this worthwhile program. #### FOOD SERVICE CHARGES

Lunch is served daily and students may bring a lunch from home if they wish. Check with our child's teacher to find out individual classroom lunch times. Lunch charges are \$2.30. The cost for the entire summer will be \$50.60. Reduced price students will be \$8.80.

Reduced lunches are \$0.40 for those that qualify under the free or reduced lunch program. (If you are a current Festus student who receives free or reduced lunch, it is not necessary to fill out additional paperwork. If you are a **non-resident of Festus/a student from another district**, you will need to fill out the proper forms if you want to receive free or reduced lunch. (Forms are available in the school office.)

Students will be allowed to charge no more than \$4.40 in meals during the summer school program. Any student owing more than \$4.40 will need to bring his or her lunch or receive the alternate meal of peanut butter and jelly and milk (The student will be charged the price of the alternate meal, \$1.20).

Just a reminder: There will be <u>NO</u> breakfast served.
