COVID-19 Update [Monday, 3/23/20]

Good Morning. I want to take a moment and provide you, our parents, staff and stakeholders, a quick update on COVID-19 as it pertains to the Festus R-VI School District.

You may have heard, St. Louis City and St. Louis County have both extended the "stay at home" mandate until April 23. Today, Jefferson County Executive Dennis Gannon issued a similar order until April 23. Based upon the spread of the virus along with how quickly and easily it is transmitted, it is in the best interest of our school community to extend the current closure of all Festus R-VI Schools through Friday, April 24th with a hopeful return date of Monday, April 27th. Until then, our operations will continue with students working with teachers online or with packets and encouraging learning opportunities at home. The 'To Go' Meal Program will continue during the closure.

Many of you are likely wondering when we will return to school. To be completely honest, I do not know that answer. However, every effort will be made to salvage even a portion of our remaining school year, up to and including Graduation.

In the meantime, I sincerely urge <u>ALL</u> of you to comply with the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control which includes social distancing AND staying at home. COVID-19 is unprecedented and will take EVERYONE doing their part to end this health crisis.
